

Code of Play at Club Sessions

Petanque Wallingford is now a large club with over 60 members, and is in the enviable position of having two terrains with different playing surfaces covering 10 or 11 pistes altogether. Some members like to take part in competitions with other clubs, and other members have no interest in doing so; this has no bearing on members' rights within the club. All members are equal, and all members are entitled to play on whichever terrain they wish. To avoid misunderstanding and argument, the following code of play should be followed at club sessions, as agreed at the AGM on 25th November 2021:

- Members will choose the terrain they wish to play on before the start of play, and will then join the throw-in for that terrain.
- If only a small number of players are available for a session, members will agree amicably how to split the play so as to ensure adequate numbers for an enjoyable game or games on one or both terrains. A simple majority vote should be used to decide, if necessary.
- Please respect the choices of other members, please be flexible, and please treat each other with courtesy.
